Background

During 2005-2006 School year a committee was formed and completed a study on space issues in the Ward 10 community.

The committee was comprised of :

- School and Community Representatives
- TDSB Facility Services Staff
- Ward 10 Trustee

A report was prepared in June 2006 and presented to the Operations and Facilities Management Committee of the TDSB

“Report from Ward 10 Advisory Committee on Space Issues”

The report proposed a number of recommendations, one of which was:

- “The Plan for Parallel Use of Vacant School Space” be adopted for implementation over the next 5 years in Ward 10

Next Steps

Assemble a Ward 10 “Review Team” to examine these opportunities and make recommendations to the TDSB and the Community for implementation.

Mandate of the Review Team

To examine the opportunities for TDSB program and community co-operative uses of TDSB school space in keeping with the recent Provincial initiatives of ‘Good Places to Learn’
